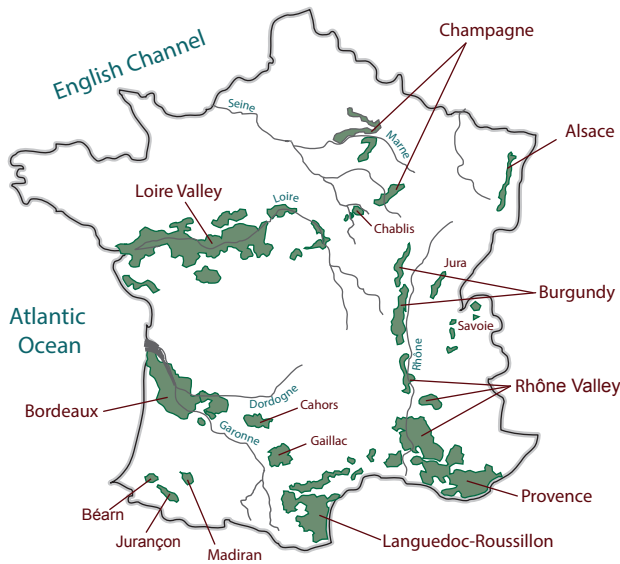

Loire & Alsace are considered by many to be two of the greatest white wine growing regions in France.

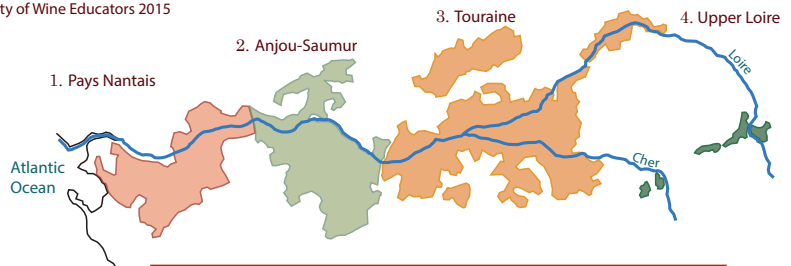
Loire is most famous for its expressions of Sauvignon Blanc; Sancerre & Pouilly-Fumé.

Don't overlook the heart of the Loire and the most important varietal historically for the area, its mistresses and castles; Chenin Blanc, in its most notable expression from Vouvray.

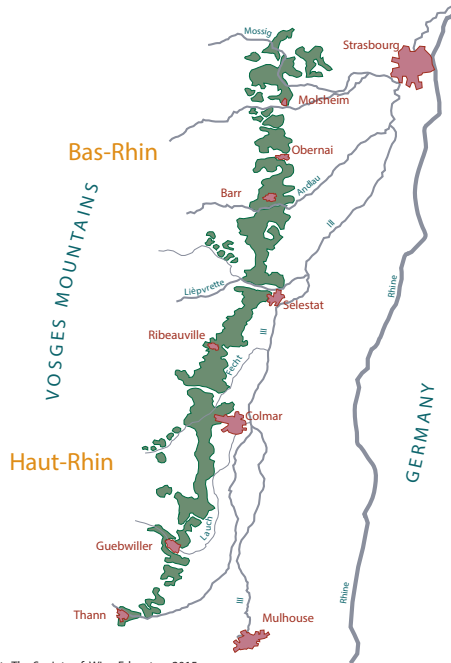
Alsace, forever influenced by its Bavarian past, produces some of the best Riesling and Gewurtztraminer, but in a classically drier more austere style.

Wine Regions of the Loire Valley

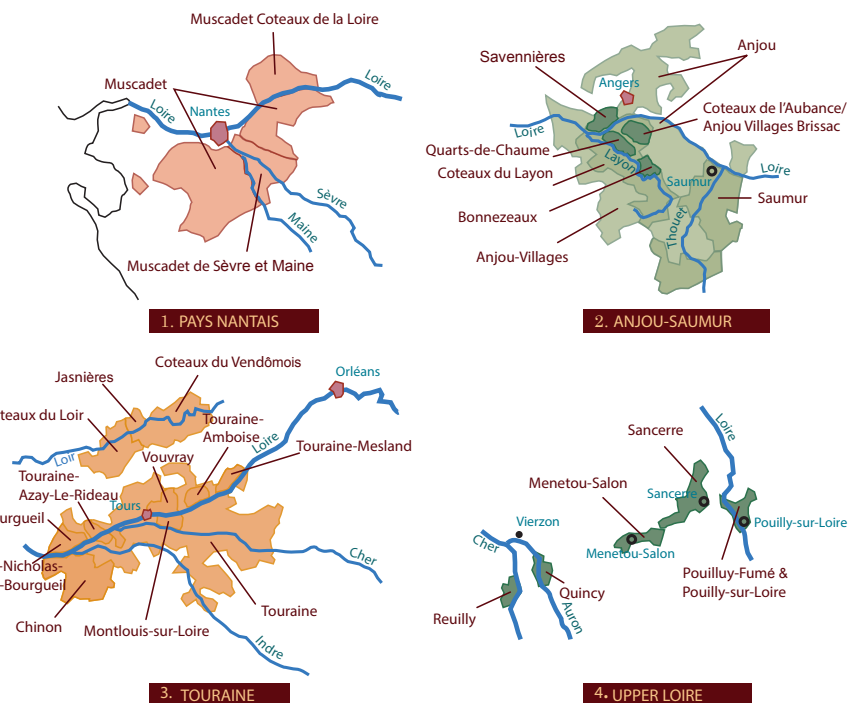

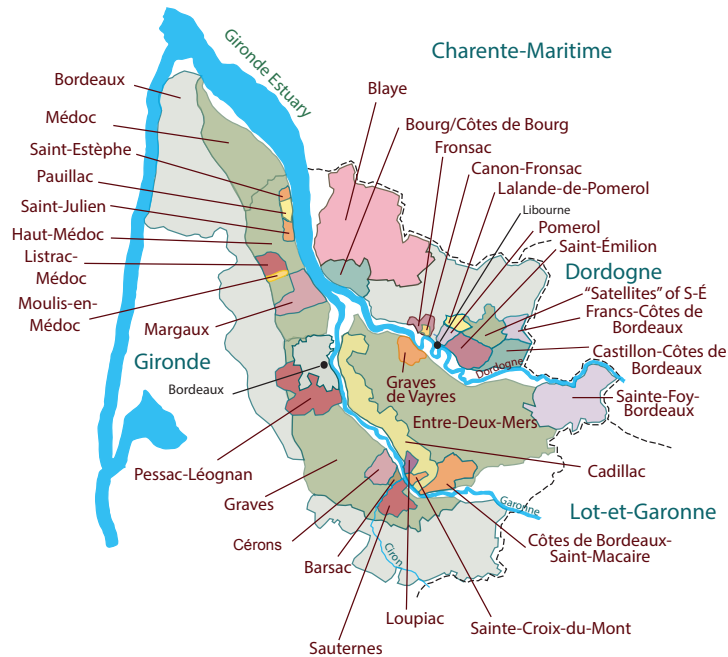

Wine Regions of Bordeaux

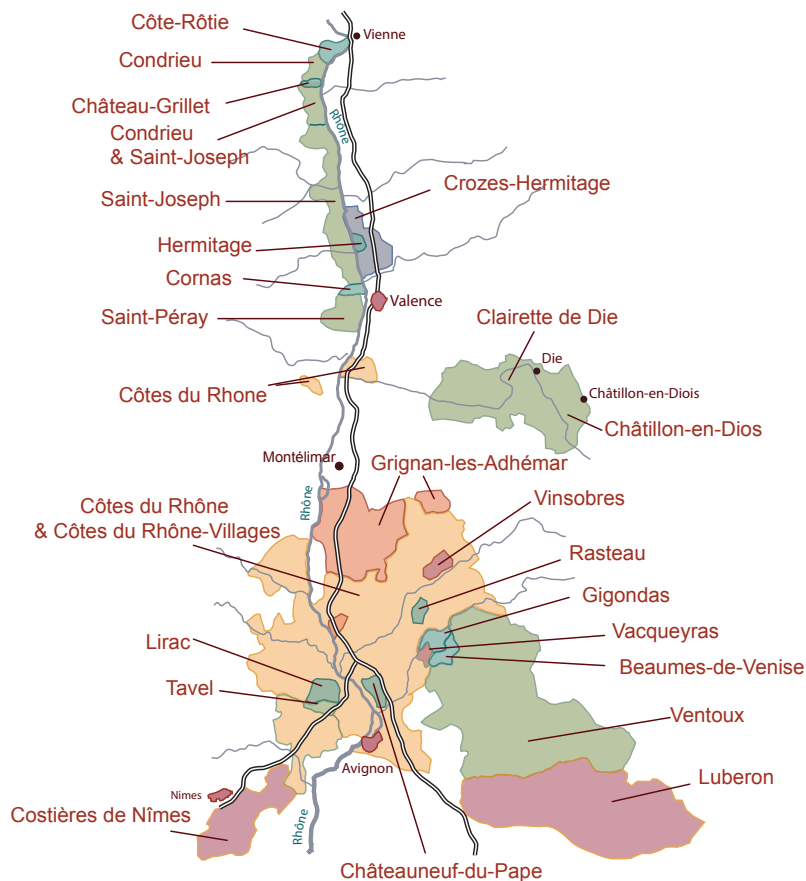

White Bordeaux wine centers around Graves. There are minute quantities of white Bordeaux produced in the Medoc (left bank) or the Libournais (right bank), most is somewhere down the middle.

Typical varietals of the area: Sauvignon Blanc, Semillion primarily, with most white wine produced a combination of the two. There is also Muscadelle, Colombar & Ugni Blanc, all of which are blending grapes.

White wines of the Rhône Valley are classically full bodied whites, with distinctive terroir.

White wines of this region can even be aged and have the character stand up to time, though in some of the most interesting cases the wine changes in the bottle over time.

White varietals abound; Roussanne, Viognier, Marsanne, Grenache Blanc - all robust. This is South of Chardonnay country, so most wines produced in this region are blends.

HISTORIC WINES = GEORGIA & TURKEY

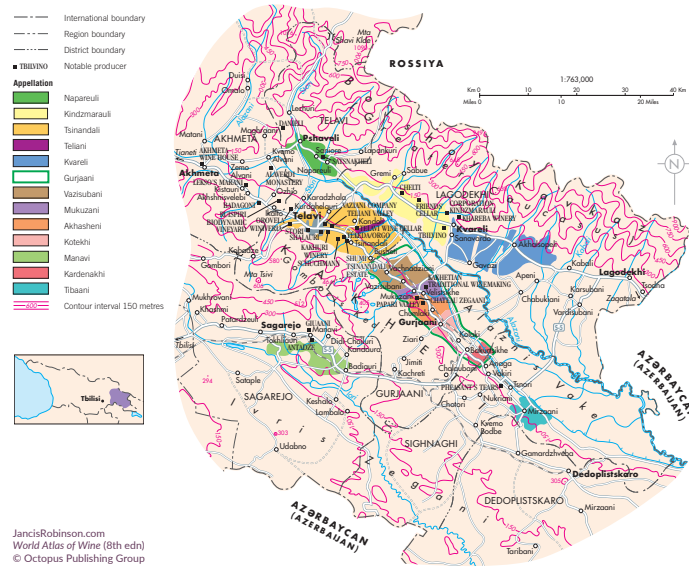

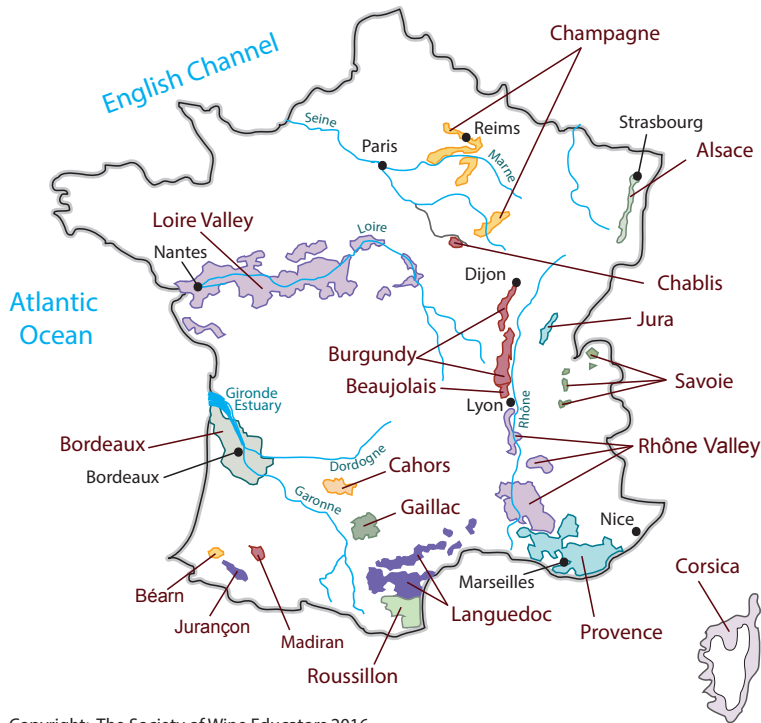

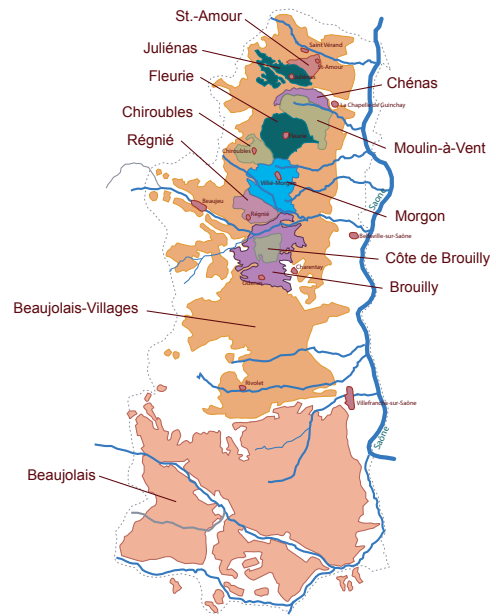

Major Wine Regions of France



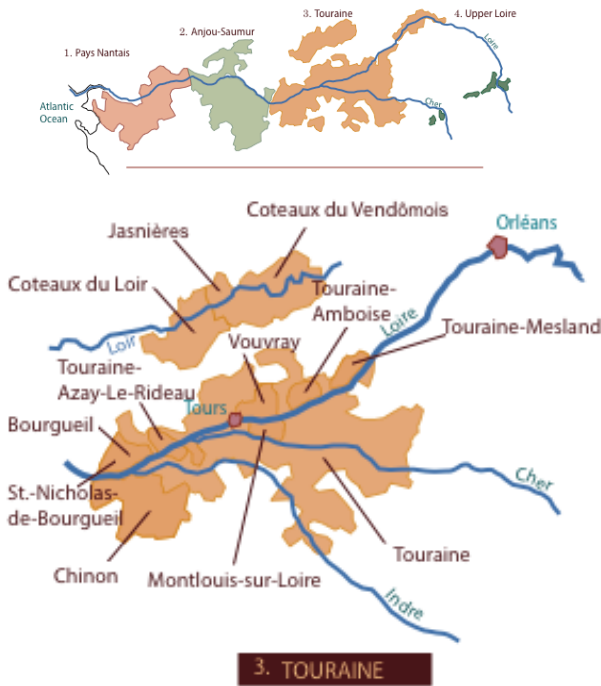

BEAUJOLAIS, LOIRE & JURA

Red wines of the **Loire**, predominantly come from the middle Loire, a lot from the region of Touraine. Gamay, Pinot Noir, as well as a smattering of other red varietals grow well in these areas and produce distinctive wines.

The focus on Gamay carries over to **Beaujolais**, as well as the growing of Pinot Noir. We offer Cru Beaujolais, and as many of the little villages as we can source. Each has a name that draws certain profiles to mind. Put away any preconceived notions you may have of Beaujolais, this is where artisan growers can afford land.

Go East, into Jura, just before the Swiss Alps and we are back to Pinot Noir. The other major red varietal of **Jura** is Poulsard, which can add a funkiness to these wines that makes them unique and food friendly. Jura is a wine lovers wine region, known for their eccentric blending and purposeful oxidation.

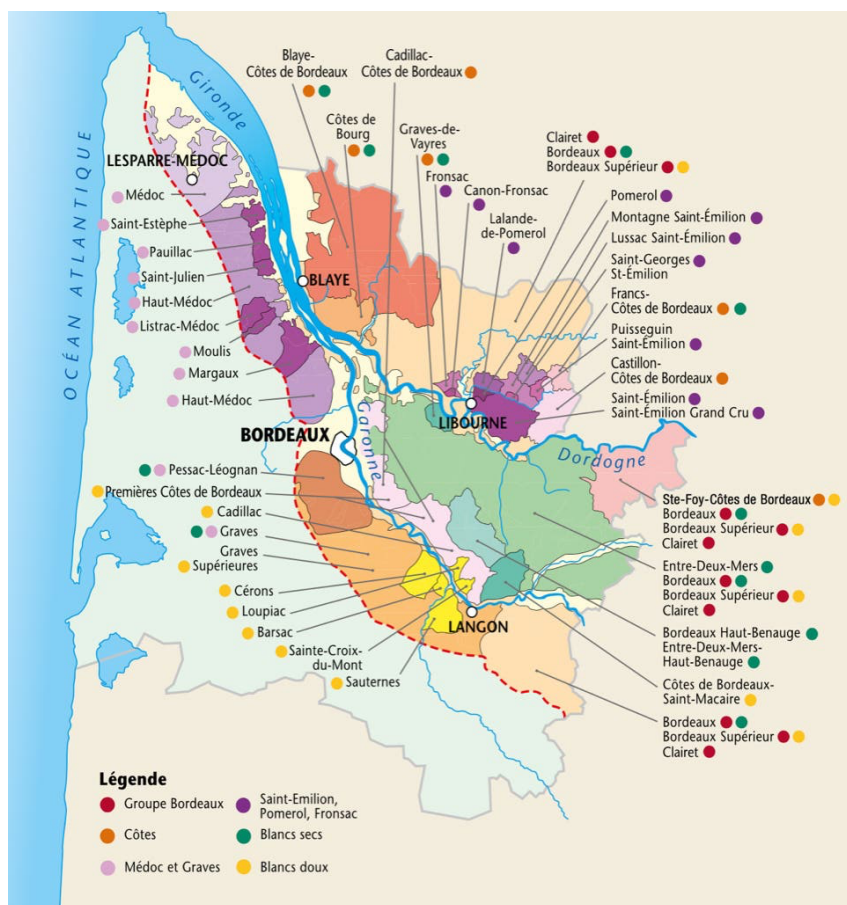

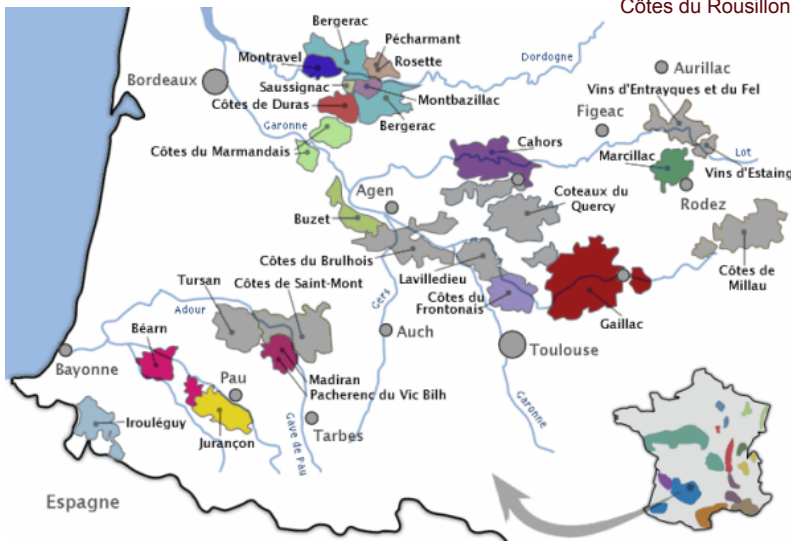

Span East towards Gascony and the wines are hearty VDP meant to go with the hearty cuisine of the region, focusing on rich varietals like Cahor, & Cabernet Franc.

Provence

Some of Chef and Desta’s favorite wines are of the Bandol in Provence. Deep black fruit, not overly structured, just luscious.

Cassis is a dream, if you are able, make this destination part of a future itinerary. Some of the oldest vinification is from this area.

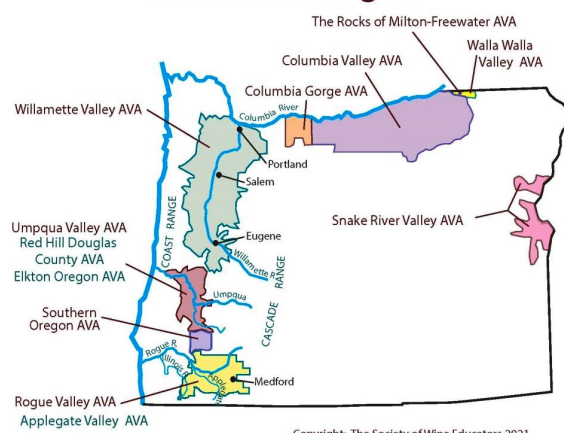

The areas of Sonoma & Napa make up only about 10-15% of the wine made in California.

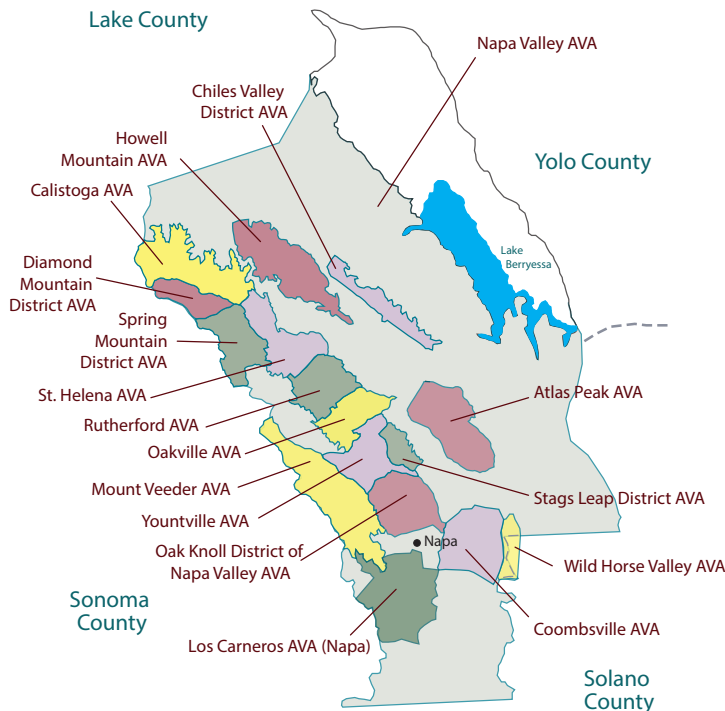
Much like France and the regions of Bordeaux & Burgundy, California is best known for these two regions and their exceptional terroir.

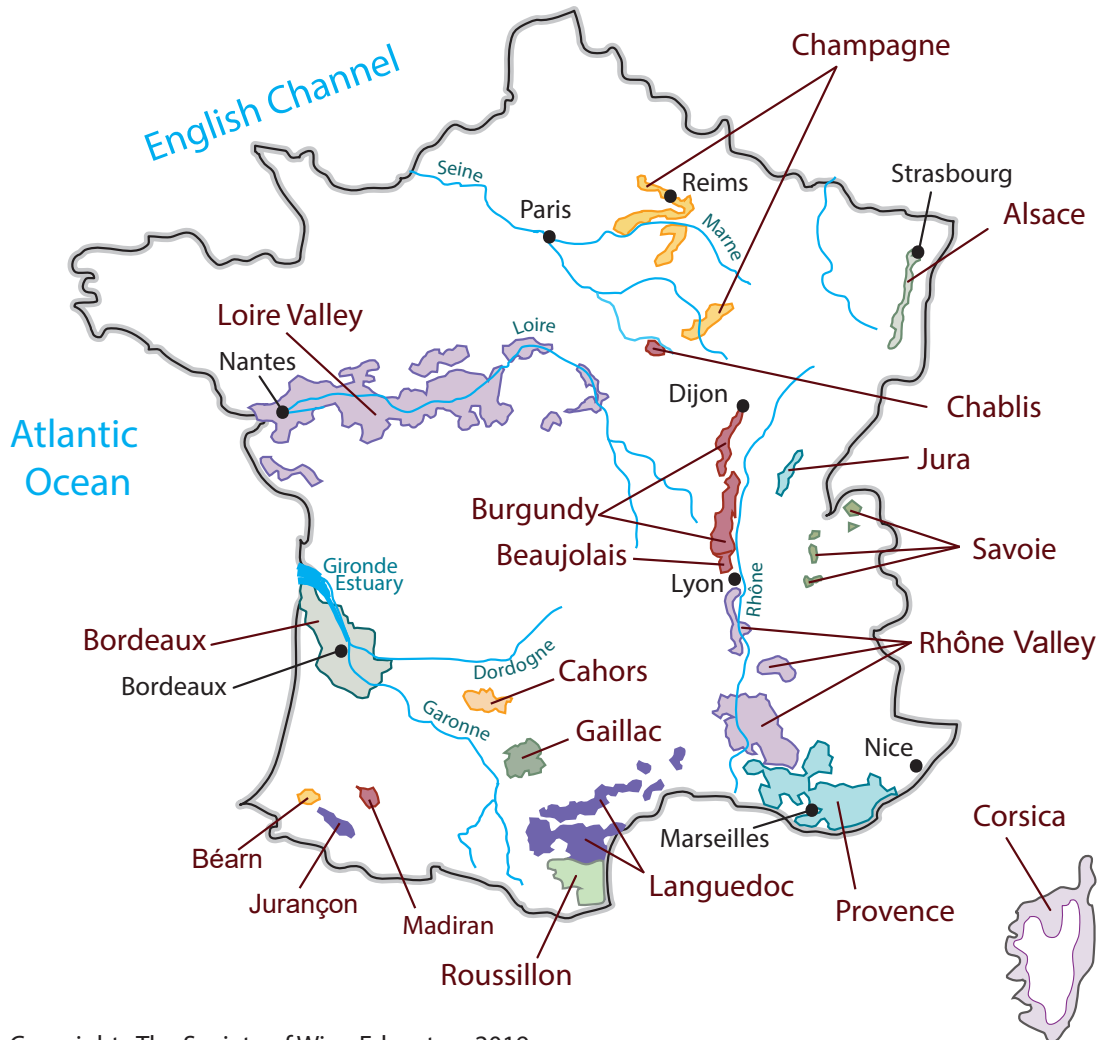
